## Summer:

- E-mail the parents' letter of recommendation to: kbracken@doanestuart.org
- Narrow down the schools to which you would like to apply
- Be sure to plan a visit at each college to which you will apply, and an interview, if offered
- Use Net Price Calculators for each college on your list, if applying for financial aid
- Schedule a meeting with Ms. Bracken (if necessary) to discuss college list
- Work on your personal statement (the main essay for Common Application schools) and start drafts of any other supplemental essays required for individual schools
- Create an account at <a href="http://www.commonapp.org">http://www.commonapp.org</a>

Throughout senior year:

- Keep Ms. Bracken informed of any communication you have with colleges (decisions, offers of aid, etc.). Be sure to share news with her within 24 hours of receiving your decision.
- Meet with admission representatives who visit Doane Stuart.
- See Ms. Bracken for guidance in evaluating and understanding financial aid packages.

## September:

Thursday, September 7	Senior Meeting with Ms. Bracken (during lunch - please pack your lunch for today)
	Confirm your two teacher recommendations with faculty members
Friday, September 8	Deadline to register for the October 7 SAT/Subject Tests
Wednesday, September 13	Submit your college list and deadlines (link to form will be emailed to seniors)
Monday, September 25	First draft of personal statement due for proofing
	All Early Action/Early Decision applications with deadlines prior to November 1 due for proofing
October:	
Sunday, October 1	The FAFSA opens. Complete yours by November 1 at www.fafsa.ed.gov. The FAFSA should be sent to every college at which you are applying for aid. Research financial aid requirements for all your schools. Complete a CSS Profile, if required, by November 1 for your EA/ED schools. Once your FAFSA has been processed, apply for TAP through NYS (if you are applying to any NY schools, public or private)
Thursday, October 5	Deadline to Register for November 4 SAT/Subject Tests

Saturday, October 7	SAT testing day
	Arrange to have your test scores sent through College Board and/or the ACT to any schools with deadlines prior to 1/1, if you have not already done so
Wednesday, October 1	All Early Action/Early Decision applications with November 1 through 15 deadlines due for proofing; SUNY and other state university applications due for proofing
	Every student should complete a Common Application by this date
	Senior College Meeting Day (PSAT testing for Sophomores & Juniors)
November:	
Wednesday, Novemb	per 1 If you are applying for financial aid, you should have completed a FAFSA by this date. If your EA/ED school(s) require(s) the CSS Profile, it should also be done by today. Be sure you submit any supplemental financial aid documents required by individual schools.
Thursday, November	2 Deadline to register for December 2 SAT/Subject Tests
Saturday, November	4 SAT testing day
Thursday, November	9 All applications with 12/1 through 12/14 deadlines due for proofing
Monday, November 2	All applications with 12/15 through 1/31 deadlines due for proofing
December:	
Saturday, December	2 SAT testing day (this is the last testing administration for seniors)
	Contact College Board and/or ACT and send test scores to any remaining schools, if necessary.
January:	
Monday, January 8	All applications with 2/1 deadlines and later due for proofing
February:	
Thursday, February	Be sure you have submitted a CSS Profile and any other required documents for regular decision financial aid (if applicable).
April:	
Sunday, April 15	Students will have heard from every college by today!
May:	
Tuesday, May 1	Students must respond to colleges regarding enrollment by today! This includes sending a deposit to the school of your choice, and declining all other offers.
	Students must inform Ms. Bracken of college choice.
