



Current Families Reapplying for Financial Aid For Fall 2020

Returning families applying for financial aid must submit a new PFS every year. The deadline to submit the 2020-21 PFS is January 10, 2020. In addition to submitting the 2020-21 PFS, we also require that the families upload their 2018 taxes and W2s to the SSS portal. Current families that do not apply for aid by the deadline risk having their aid cut. The Financial Aid Committee will review the applications and then include the grant award in the re-enrollment packets that will be mailed out in February. Families then have until March 6 to accept the award.

Once a family has completed their 2019 taxes, they must upload their taxes and W2s to their 2020-21 PFS on the SSS Portal. This should be done as soon as possible but must be done by April 15, barring any special circumstances. The Financial Aid Committee will then use the 2019 taxes and W2s to review the grant. If there are no significant changes from what was reported in the PFS, then the grant will remain the same. Families that see a significant increase or decrease in salary will have their grants modified accordingly. Please be in contact with Cecil Stodghill (518) 465-5222, if you have any questions.

Financial Aid Timeline for 2019-20 (current families)

- January 10 - 2020-21 PFS, 2018 taxes and W2s due on SSS Portal
- February - Financial Aid grants distributed with re-enrollment packets
- March 6 - Re-enrollment deadline
- April 15 - Due date for uploading 2019 taxes and W2s on SSS portal
